Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Locally heavy rain will continue across northwestern parts of England and Wales and Western Scotland, and remaining misty and drizzly on some western and southern coasts and hills. However, central and southern parts will be warmer with drier, brighter spells.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday: Rain, locally heavy in the north will clear to brighter spells and scattered showers. The southeast corner will become warm or very warm with sunny spells and possible thundery showers.

Saturday: Many places dry with sunny spells, but with scattered showers, especially in the north and east with possible thunder. Feeling locally warm in the southeast, but fresher elsewhere.
