

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 15 Aug 2013

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
The heavier rain over northern parts should quickly clear east, leaving bright spells for most and a few sharp showers. More persistent and heavy rain will move in from the west this afternoon and spread southeastwards across much of England and Wales overnight. Elsewhere it will be drier although further rain is likely over western Scotland.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The rain, with hill fog and coastal mist, will continue southeastwards across southern Wales and southern England on Friday. Northern areas will have sunny spells and scattered showers, these locally heavy over northern Scotland. Breezy, with widespread and persistent rain spreading eastwards through Saturday.
