Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Showers or more prolonged outbreaks of rain largely dying out this morning. Many places quite sunny for a time, but Northern Ireland becoming cloudy this morning, this cloud covering most places by evening. Rain and strengthening winds reaching Northern Ireland in the afternoon, spreading across all parts tonight. Clearer with showers in Northern Ireland and much of Scotland later.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain clearing all parts by Sunday evening, followed by showers, heavy at times in the west and south. Gales in south. Showery on Monday, only places east of hills seeing much sun. Early gales in south, then winds and showers easing.
