Headline:

Rain spreading east, southeast staying dry, becoming colder in west.

This Evening and Tonight:

Rain spreading slowly across Wales/N.England. N.Ireland clearer with showers, risk icy patches. Elsewhere breezy, patchy drizzle.

Saturday:

E.England mainly dry, brighter in southeast. Rain most other places, sleet/snow on hills in NW.Scotland. Colder in west. Showers, bright intervals far west.

Outlook for Sunday:

Scotland/N.Ireland cloudy, rain at times, snow on hills, windy far west for a time. England/Wales mostly cloudy, some rain/drizzle. West colder.
