

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rather cloudy in central and eastern areas, with outbreaks of light rain or drizzle at times. Brighter and drier in the north and west with sunny intervals. Light winds across Scotland; brisk northeasterlies making it feel rather cool elsewhere. Risk of heavy rain and showers pushing into the south this evening and overnight.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Southern areas rather cloudy with rain or showers on Friday, though parts of Scotland and northwest England and Wales may stay mainly dry and bright. An improving picture on Saturday, with most places dry throughout. Many also seeing some sunshine, the best of this in the west.
