Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain affecting North Sea coastal counties will clear all but Shetland through the afternoon. Further heavy showers will affect a good part of England and Wales. Some torrential downpours, with a risk of hail and thunder, are possible across southern England and the Midlands especially. Elsewhere, some sunshine. Drier overnight, and turning chilly under clear skies in the west.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Somewhat quieter on Saturday, with plenty of sunshine for most of Scotland, Northern Ireland, Wales and western England. Breezy and cloudy across central and eastern England, with outbreaks of rain. Mainly dry on Sunday, and sunniest in the west once again.
