Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Today will be windy and cold with sunshine. Showers will be confined to western parts and northern Scotland, where they will fall as snow on hills. Gales will affect northern coasts and hills. A cold and mostly clear night will bring frost to central areas in spite of the northwesterly breeze. Showers are likely near western and eastern coasts.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

After a frosty start, tomorrow will be mostly dry and sunny. It will feel milder than today in lighter winds. Showers will affect eastern coasts, and also Pembrokeshire and Cornwall. On Saturday, heavy rain and snow will move across the UK.
