

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Monday 27 Aug 2012

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain in western regions gradually spreading eastwards, though always heaviest on western high ground. Southeast England seeing only intermittent lighter rain, with some brighter, warmer intervals. Northern Ireland becoming brighter with scattered showers in the afternoon, then Scotland and Wales following suit in the evening, and England becoming largely dry by dawn. Strong southerly winds with the rain, easing overnight.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:
Tuesday much brighter with some sunshine for most and a scattering of sharp showers in the west, though many places will remain dry. Wednesday unsettled once again with showers or more prolonged rain, sometimes heavy, accompanied by gusty southwesterly winds.
