Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore  
for the period 0600 UTC Monday 02 June to 0600 UTC Tuesday 03 June 2014

#### General Situation

An area of low pressure will slowly track northeastwards between Iceland and northwest Scotland during the next 48 hours, with associated fronts gradually moving east across the United Kingdom. A second developing Atlantic low will then follow behind, becoming centred to the west of Scotland by midday Tuesday.

#### Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in east, becoming variable 3 or less later in west.

Smooth or slight in inner Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Good becoming moderate, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southeasterly 4 or 5 occasionally 6 until later in east, otherwise variable 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight in inner Moray Firth, otherwise slight or moderate.

Rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southeasterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 near Rattray Head, veering southwesterly 3 or 4 later in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 5 or 6 at first in north, otherwise southerly or southwesterly becoming variable later, 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Rain at first in north, otherwise showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

#### Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 4 or 5, veering south 3 or 4 later.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Occasional rain or showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less.

Slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor.

#### Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southeast, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeast, 3 or 4, becoming variable 3 or less later.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers then rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland  
24 hour forecast:  
Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Mainly fair then showers.  
Good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers then rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwesterly 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly veering westerly later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 for a time.  
Slight, occasionally smooth at first.  
Showers then rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis  
24 hour forecast:  
Southwest 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Westerly or southwesterly, veering northwesterly later in west, 3 or 4,  
increasing 5 at times.  
Slight, occasionally moderate near headlands.  
Showers then rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain with fog patches, then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
West veering northwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Slight or moderate.  
Showers then rain later.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel  
24 hour forecast:  
West or southwest 3 or 4.  
Slight or moderate.  
Rain with fog patches, then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West veering northwest later, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Showers then rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate later in far south.

Occasional rain with fog patches, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering west or northwest later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate near St Davids Head.

Showers, rain later in south.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor later in south.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain with fog patches, then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest veering northwest later, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Good, occasionally poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 3 or 4.

Slight.

Occasional rain.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

West or southwest 2, increasing 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Showers.

Moderate or good.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

South veering west or southwest, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Smooth or slight.

Rain then showers.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwest, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Showers.

Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly veering westerly or southwesterly, 3 or 4.

Smooth or slight.

Rain then showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southwesterly, 3 or 4.  
Smooth or slight.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point  
24 hour forecast:  
South or southwest, veering west for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, but 5 or 6 in far northwest.  
Slight in shelter, otherwise moderate, occasionally rough later in northwest.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

The Minch  
24 hour forecast:  
South veering west for a time, 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.  
Smooth or slight, occasionally moderate at first.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly veering southwesterly for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Smooth or slight, but moderate in far south.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath  
24 hour forecast:  
South veering west for a time, 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.  
Moderate.  
Rain or showers.  
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:  
Southerly or southeasterly, veering southwesterly for a time, 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west.  
Moderate, occasionally rough in west.  
Showers.  
Good, occasionally moderate at first.

Shetland Isles

General Situation  
A trough of low pressure will persist to the west of Shetland on Monday and Tuesday.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: Nil

Southeast 5 or 6, occasionally 7 later.

Moderate.  
Occasional rain and fog patches, mainly in west.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor mainly in west.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Monday 02 Jun until 0600 UTC on Tuesday 03 Jun:

Southeast 5 to 7.  
Moderate.  
Occasional rain and fog patches, mainly in west.  
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor mainly in west.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southwest 2 to 3, occasionally 4, locally variable 1 or 2 south of jersey this afternoon, veering westerly this evening.

Smooth or slight.

Occasional rain or drizzle, with the risk of fog patches, clearing later this evening, then isolated showers.

Moderate to good, locally poor or very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Westerly 2 to 4, backing southwest 2 or 3 for a time overnight, veering west to northwest increasing 3 to 4, locally 5 in the west later.

Slight with a low swell, becoming locally moderate later.

Isolated showers rain overnight.

Good, locally moderate.

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
