

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Thursday 23 Oct 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be milder but rather cloudy for most, with occasional rain almost
anywhere. The rain will be heaviest and more persistent in the west,
particularly western Scotland. There will be a few brighter interludes in the
south and east. Further outbreaks of rain are likely overnight, though clearer
and breezy conditions will edge in from the northwest.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

On Friday there will be outbreaks of rain ahead of a more persistent band which
will push eastwards. Brighter weather will follow, although some showers are
expected in the northwest. Saturday should be drier for many, with showery rain
towards the northwest.
