

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Starting dry, chilly and sunny in many places. Through today cloud will increase from the west, bringing outbreaks of rain to Northern Ireland then to western England, Wales and western Scotland. Drier conditions will follow to Northern Ireland. Overnight rain will continue east, clearing much of Scotland while reaching southeast England and East Anglia. Elsewhere scattered showers following the rain.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Saturday rain, perhaps locally heavy at first, clearing from East Anglia and southeast England. Then sunshine and scattered, sometimes heavy, showers. Becoming dry in many places through the evening. Sunday wet and very windy weather spreading northeast across the UK.
