Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Some dry and bright weather, however showers developing across eastern Scotland, as well as northern and eastern England, where a few heavy and thundery ones are possible. Increasingly cloudy and becoming breezier for western Scotland and Northern Ireland, with some occasional rain by evening, and this will push slowly eastwards overnight. Feeling reasonably warm in the sunshine.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:  
Occasional rain over western England and Wales will continue moving east on Tuesday, fizzling out before it reaches southeast England. A few showers for Scotland and Northern Ireland. Occasional rain or showers for many areas on Wednesday. Breezy, with temperatures around average.
