Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
England and Wales should be dry and warm with some sunshine, though some western coasts will remain dull and misty. Rain across Scotland will spread southwards across Northern Ireland and later northern England with colder weather following to the north. Overnight, rain clearing southwards and turning colder everywhere with wintry showers in the north by morning.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

It will be cold with strong north or northwesterly winds bringing a mixture of clear or sunny spells and wintry showers. Some of the showers will be heavy and prolonged and will bring snow to some areas, especially, but not exclusively for northern hills.
