Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
It will be a cold start across the UK once again with the possibility of one or two light snow flurries across eastern England. Otherwise, much of the UK will be dry with some sunny spells. However, northwestern parts will be cloudy and windy, with outbreaks of rain and these conditions will gradually spread across Scotland.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

The outbreaks of rain across northwestern areas will gradually spread southeastwards to most parts, preceded by spells of snow for some. However the far southeast of England is likely to remain dry, bright, but cold with a continuing risk of overnight frost.
