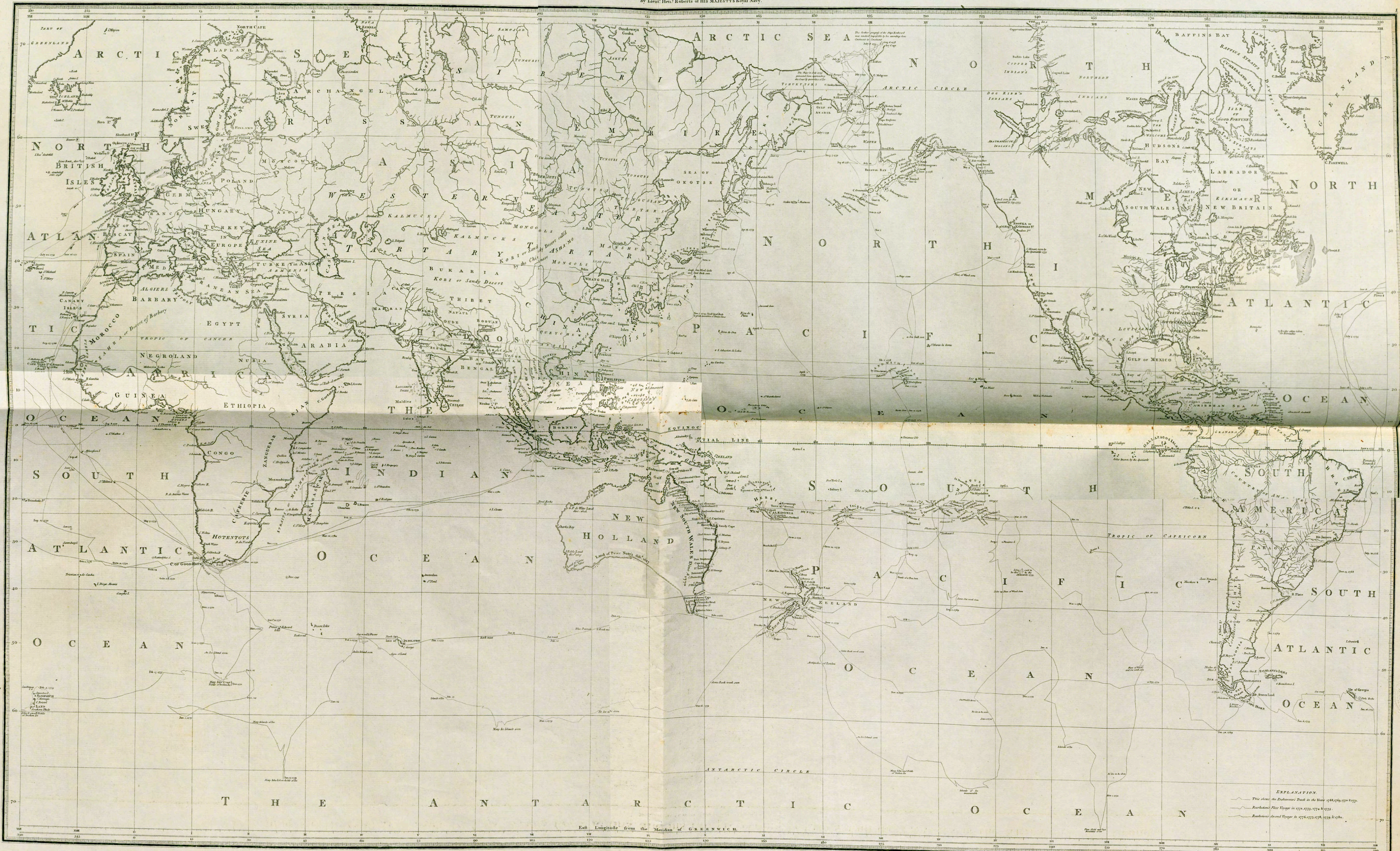

1771 & 1779

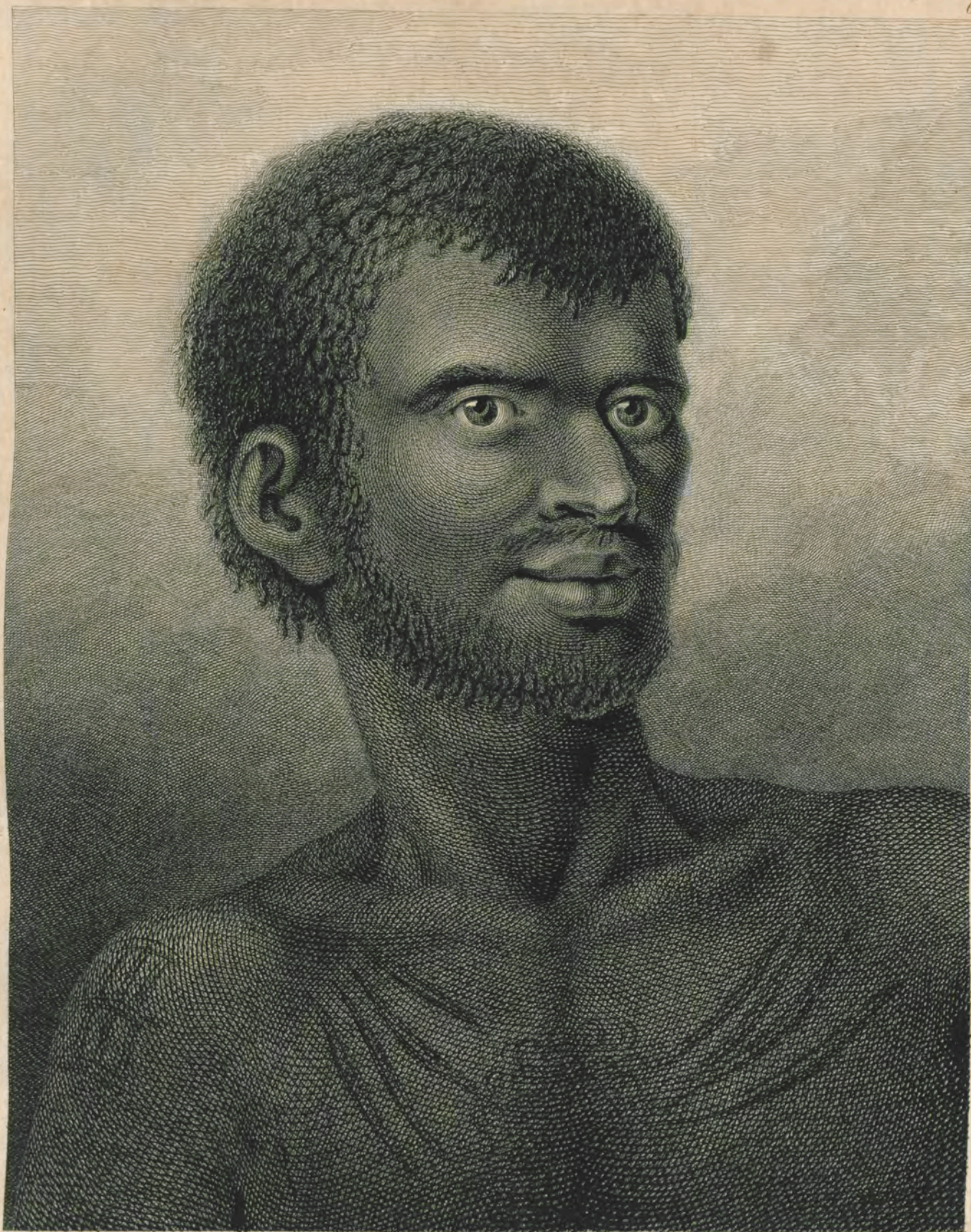

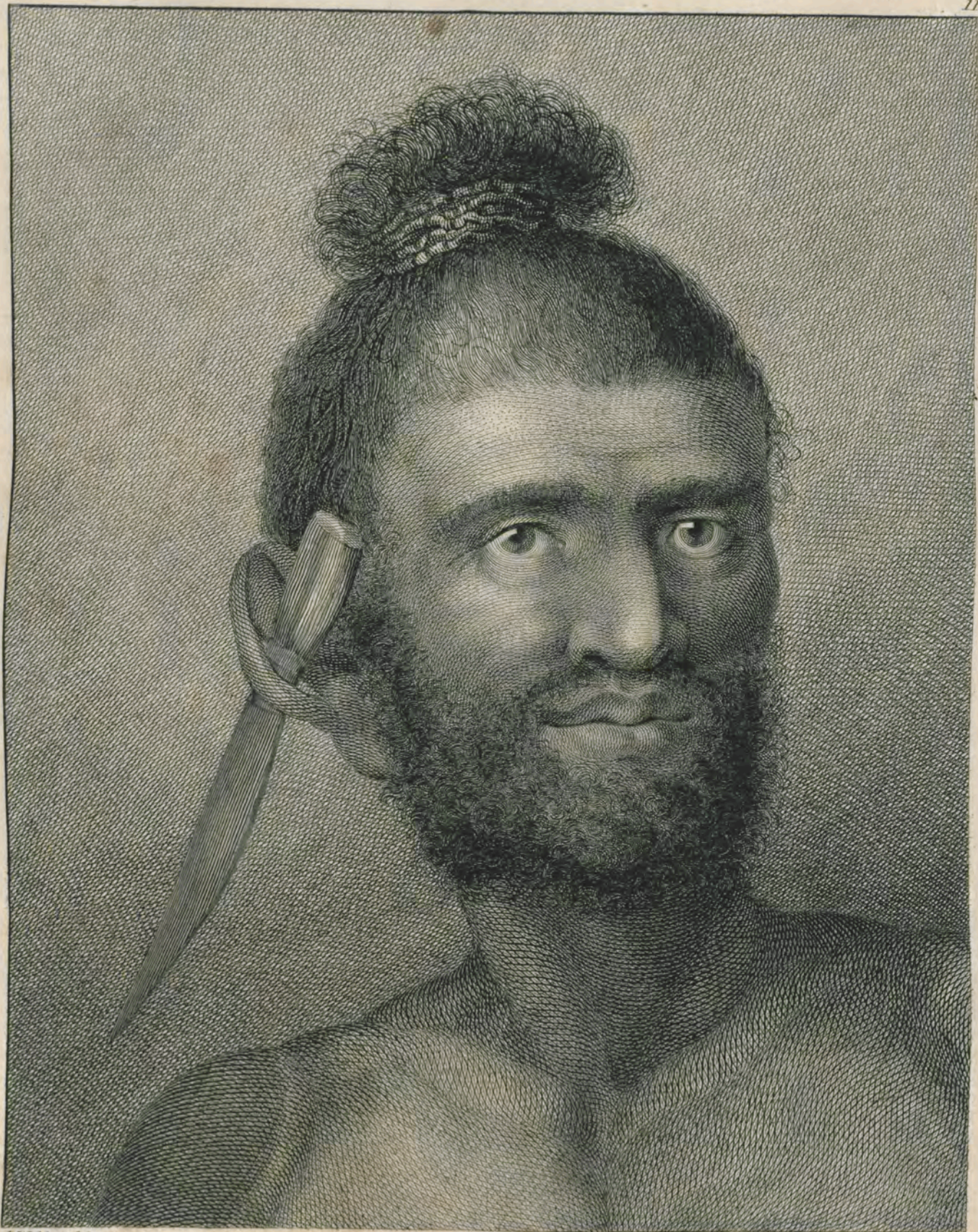

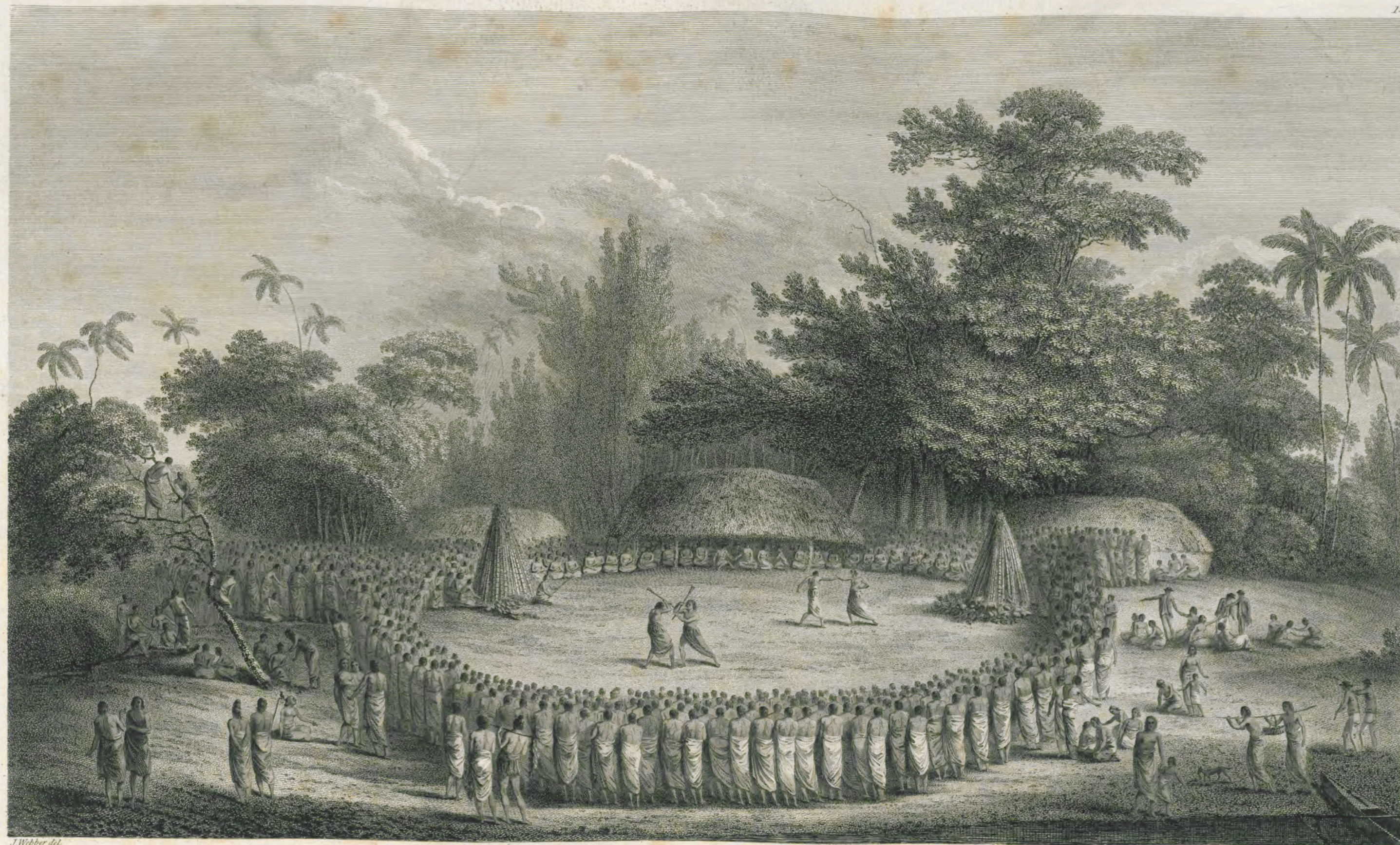

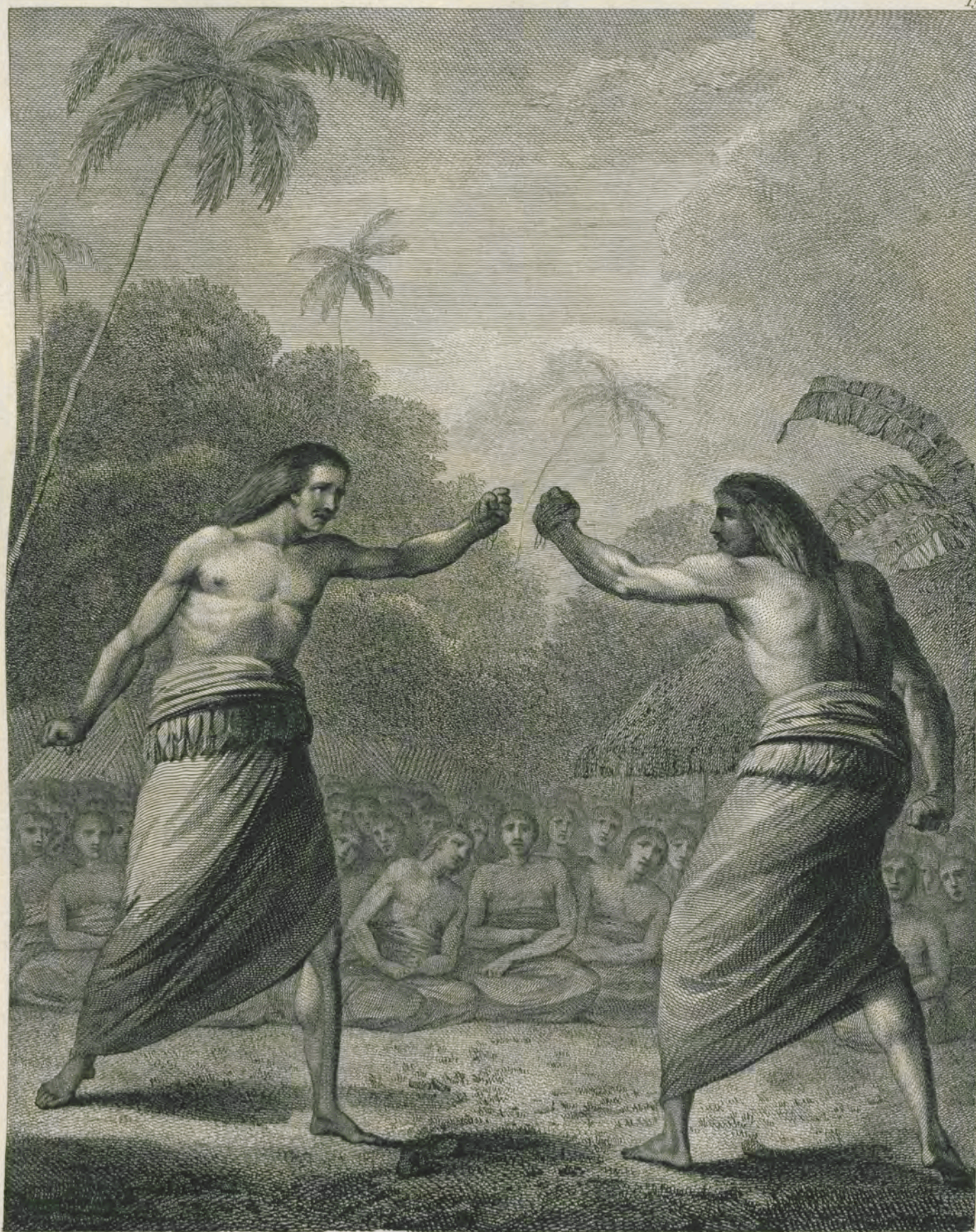

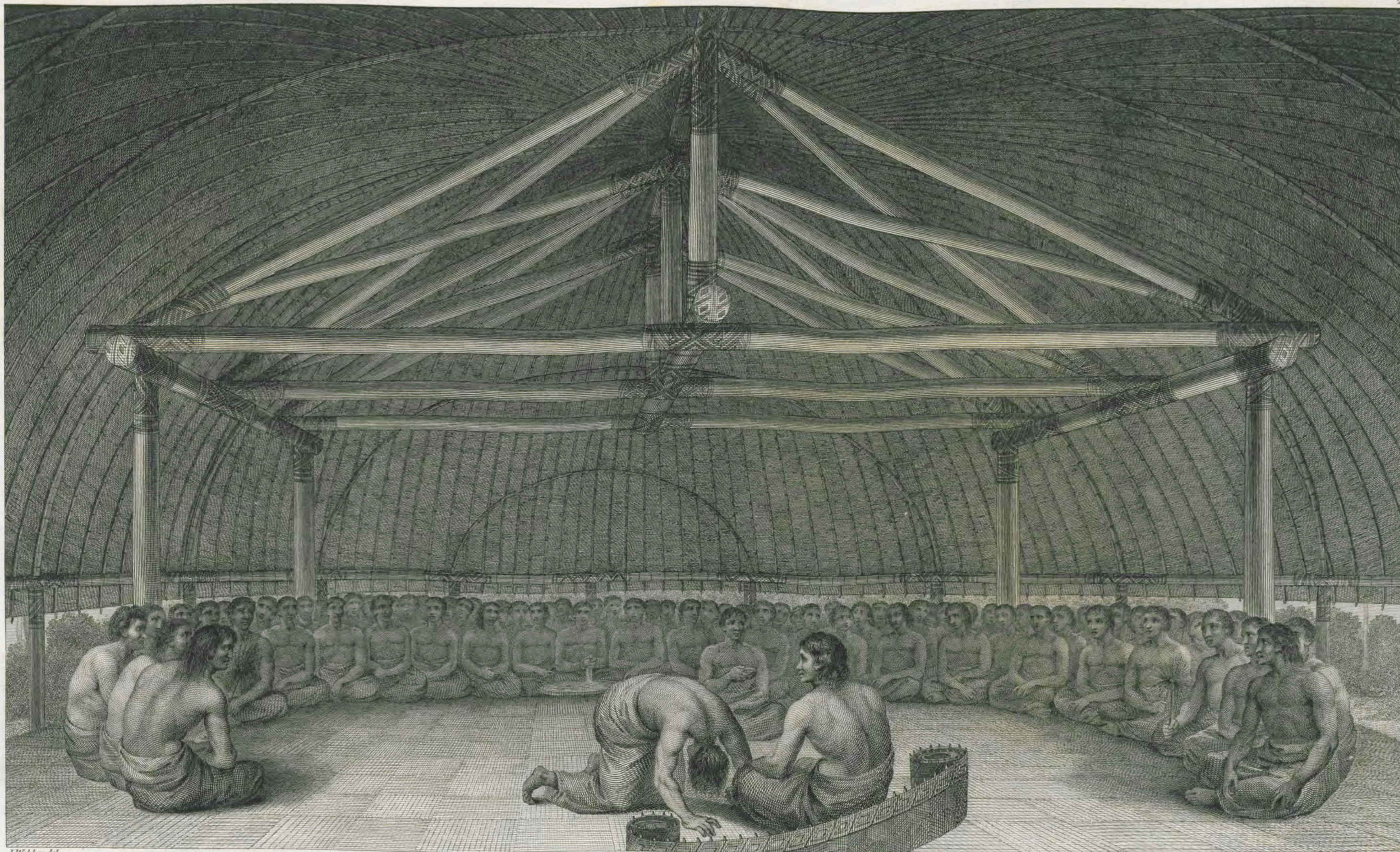

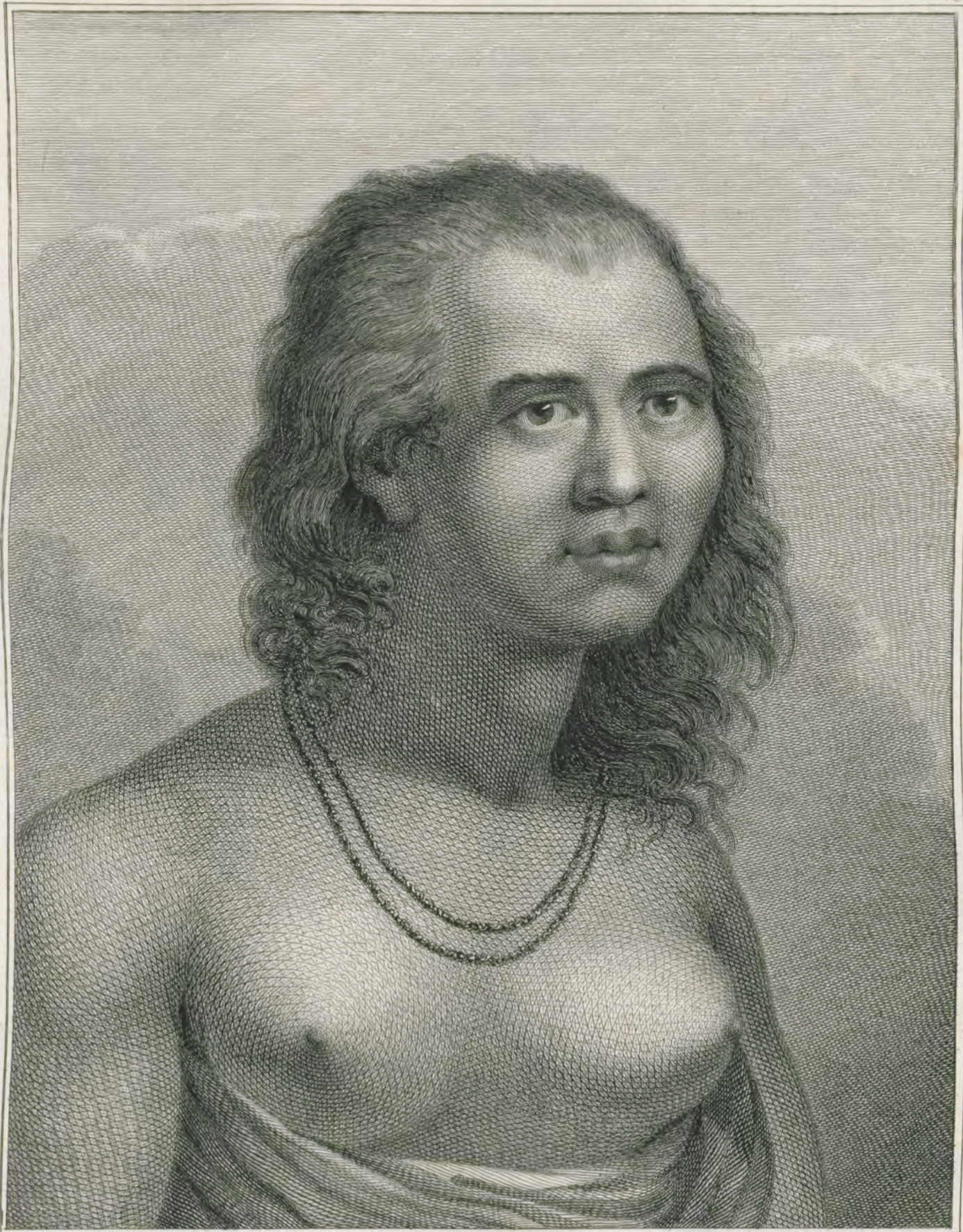

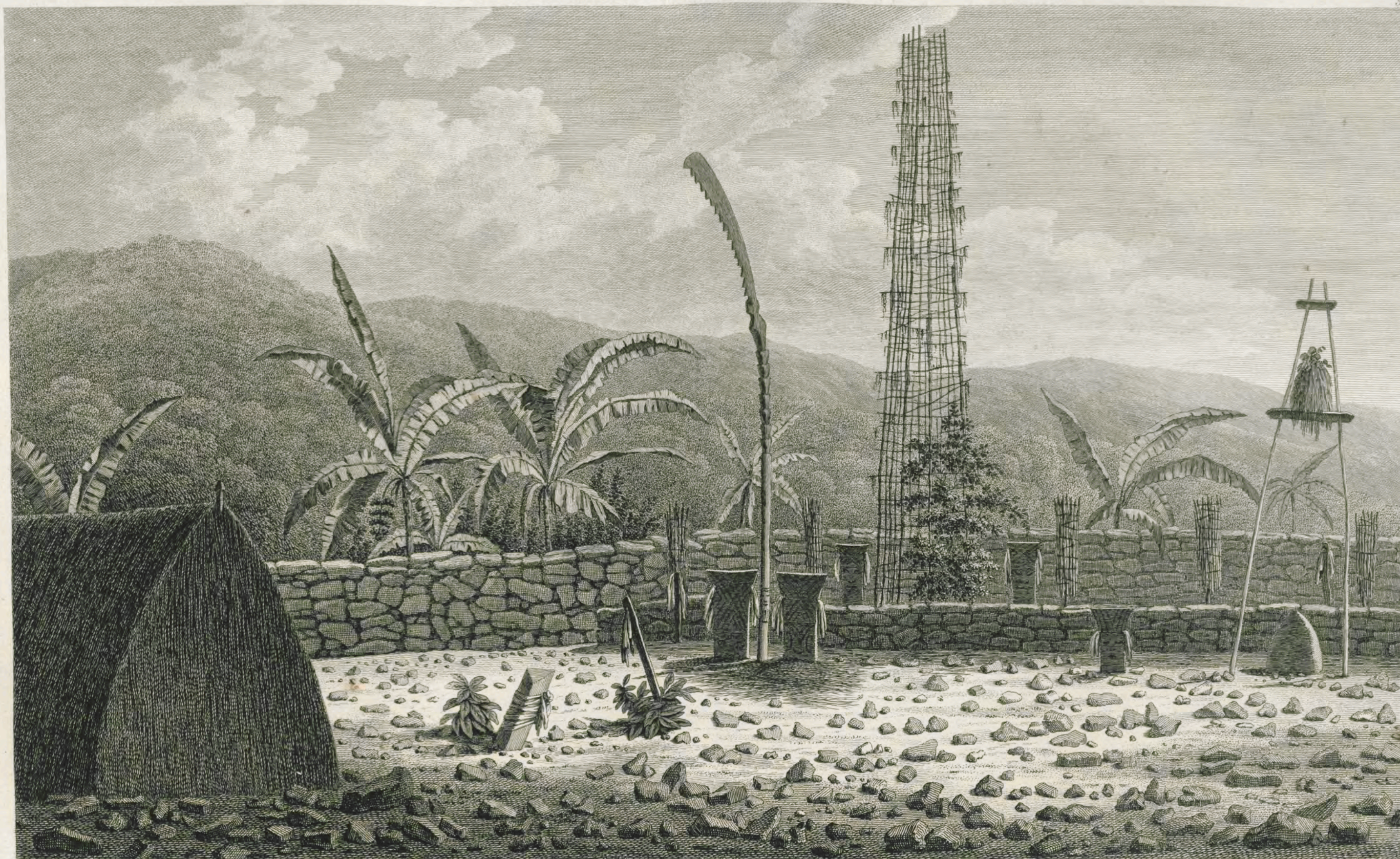

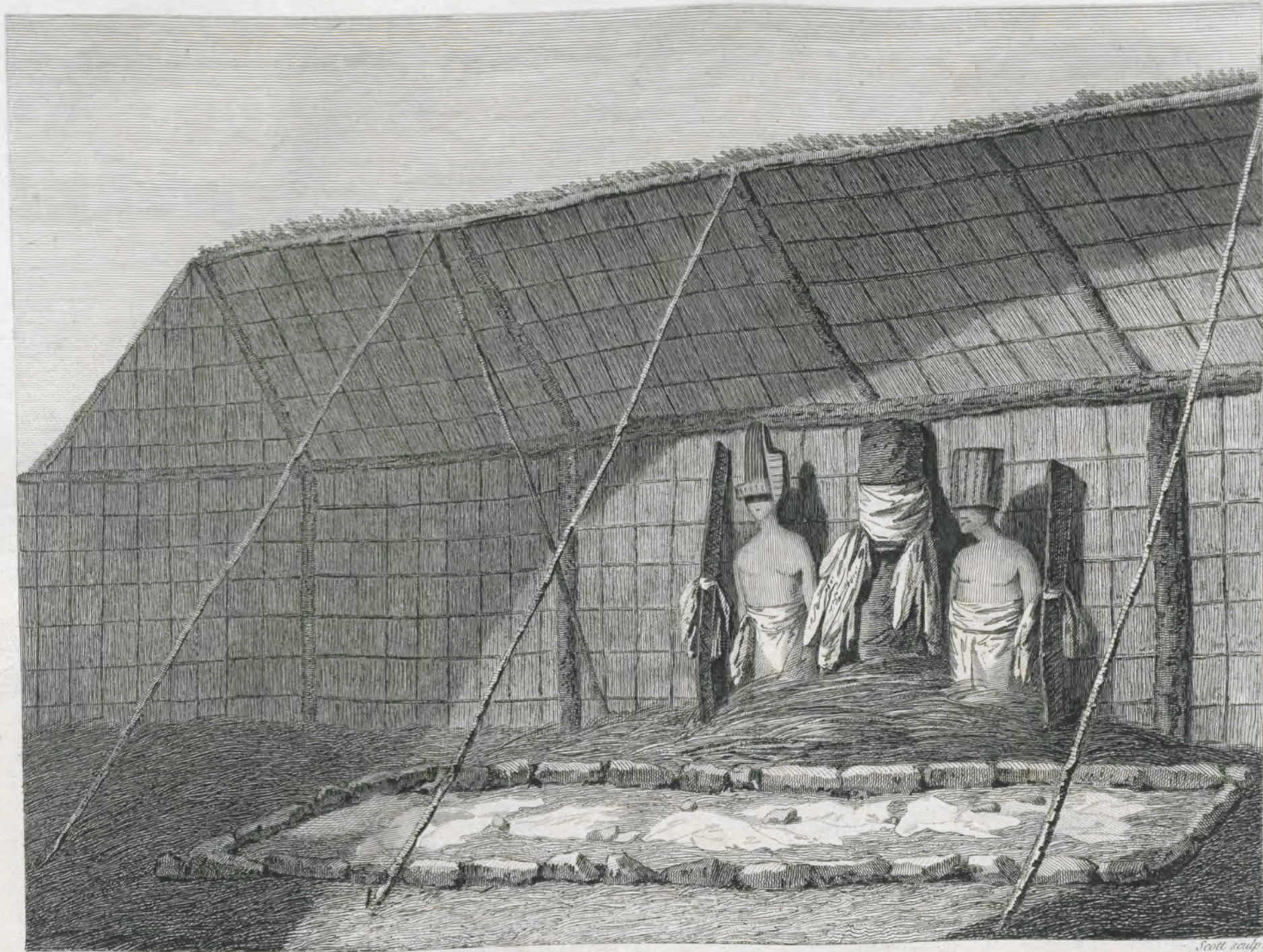

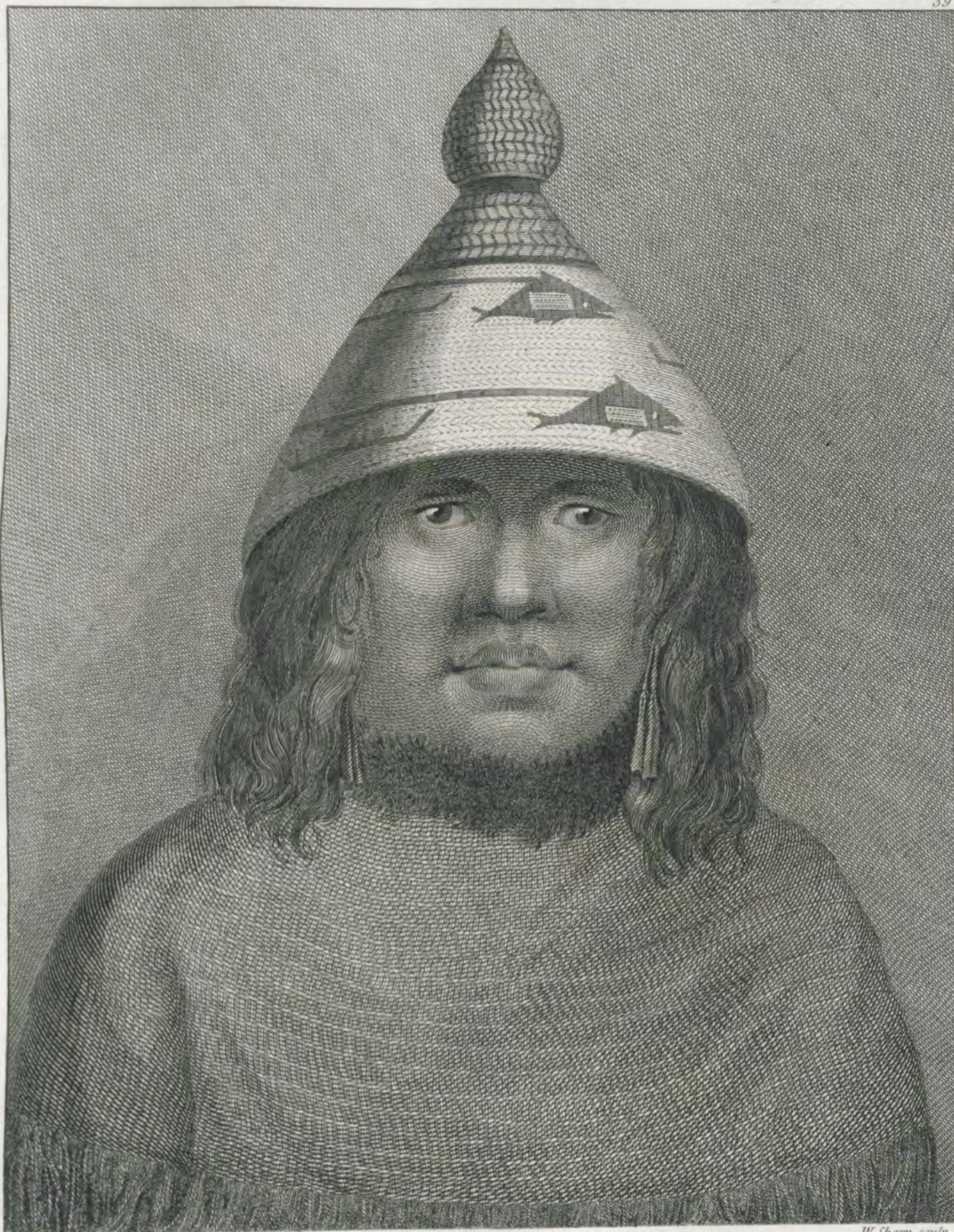

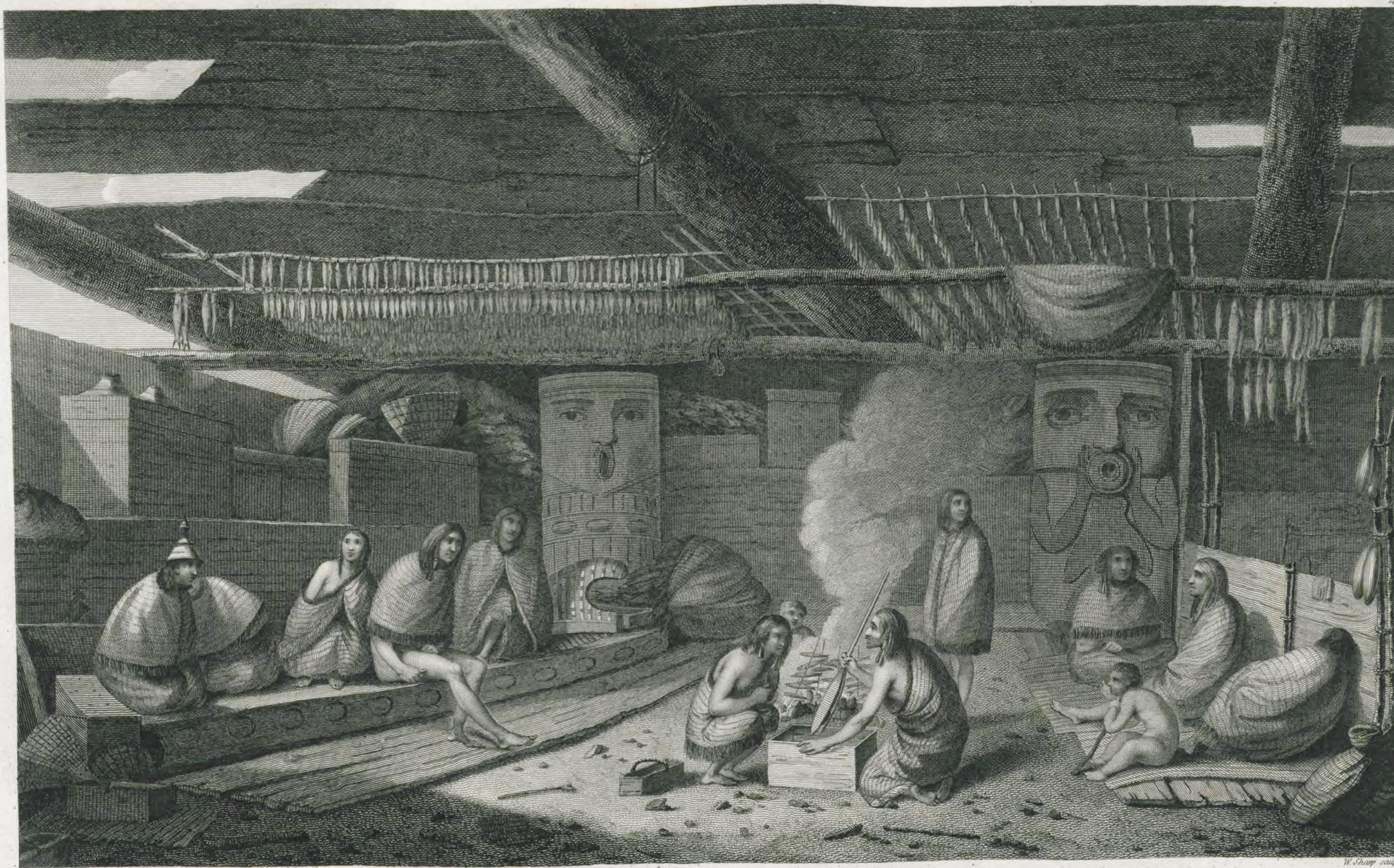

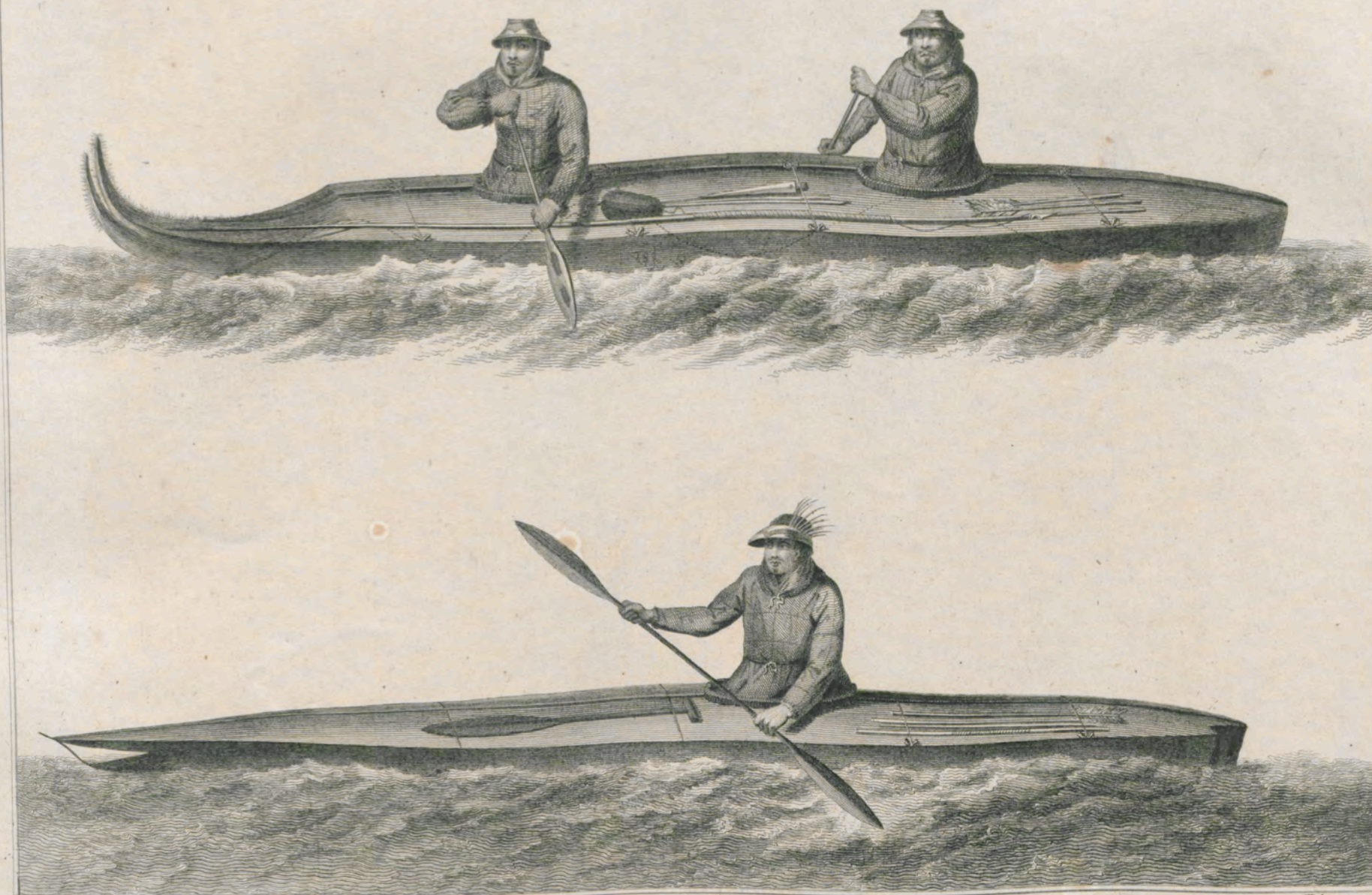

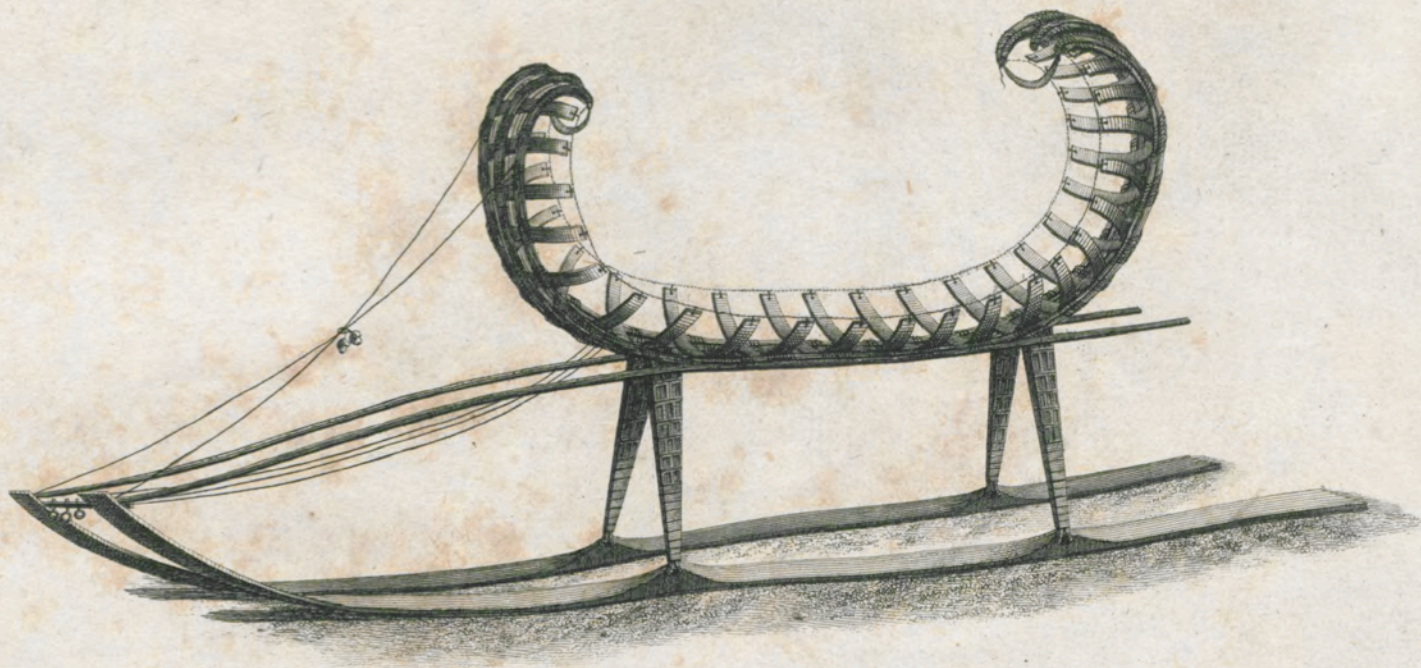
