Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
Northern Scotland, a cold and frosty start but with rain spreading
northeast, preceded by sleet or snow.
Northern Ireland and the rest of Scotland: further bands of rain
spreading northeast but some drier and brighter spells as well.
England and Wales:- bright or sunny spells at first but with rain
spreading from the southwest from late morning onwards, although with
southeastern areas staying mainly dry until evening.

Windy at times, especially in the west with a risk of gales. Cold in
the north at first otherwise most places mild.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:
Cloudy, mild and windy with rain at times, some heavy.
