

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Breezy with showers in northwestern parts, and also rather cloudy with showery rain in central and southern England this morning. But in-between, it should be largely dry and warm with sunny spells, and becoming very warm in the far southeast. Dry for most places overnight with clear spells, but further showers in the northwest, and perhaps the far southeast.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Breezy with showers in the northwest during Saturday, some heavy, with perhaps more persistent rain later. Elsewhere, mainly dry and bright with sunny spells. During Sunday, a spell of wind and rain is likely for most areas, particularly in the north.
