

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Mainly light rain, sleet and snow across northern England and Scotland should gradually become confined to northern Scotland. Some wintry showers will feed into western areas, heavy with hail at times. Elsewhere should be dry with some low cloud, and fog in the south, but some sunny spells should develop, most likely in the afternoon. Rather cold generally.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Early fog and frost will be widespread on Monday, but it should be dry and gradually become brighter. Rain will spread across northern and western parts later, before becoming widespread during Tuesday. Sunny spells and showers following into the northwest through Tuesday.
