Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:

A band of rain moving northeastwards will bring a wet and dull start for most, and some of the rain may be heavy at times. By lunchtime, cloud and rain will have reached Scotland with only the far north staying dry. Into the afternoon, brighter and much drier intervals will develop although it will remain windy. Feeling mild.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

After a chilly start for some on Sunday, it'll once again become unsettled as heavy rain moves northwards across the UK, with the driest and brightest weather in the east. A wet and windy picture continues into the beginning of the week.
