Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Showers affect many areas of the UK today, with some of these becoming persistent, heavy and thundery, particularly over central and eastern England. It will also become windy across the UK making it feel quite cool. Most of the showers will die out this evening and overnight with some clear spells developing but it remains windy.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

Friday will be drier, brighter and less windy although there will still be a few showers in the east, and it will turn cloudier towards northwest Britain later. Some brighter spells on Saturday but with a chance of further rain in places. Staying cool.
