General Situation

High pressure will dominate the southern half of the United Kingdom. Strong winds across Scottish waters are expected to ease this evening, with strong easterly winds through the English Channel for much of tomorrow.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 5 to 7, increasing gale 8 at times until later in north, occasionally 4 later in Moray Firth.

Rough or very rough in north, slight in east, occasionally moderate at first in far east.

Occasional rain or drizzle.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 3 or 4 later.

Rough or very rough in north, smooth or slight in east.

Occasional rain later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill
24 hour forecast:
Variable 3 or less, becoming easterly 4 or 5 later.
Smooth or slight.
Mainly fair.
Good, occasionally poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in west, veering southeasterly 3 or 4 later.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel

Slight or moderate, occasionally rough later in southwest.

East or southeast 4 or 5, increasing 6 at times.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

Smooth or slight, becoming slight or moderate.

Lough Foyle to Carlingford Lough

24 hour forecast:

West or southwest 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, becoming variable 2 to 4.

Moderate or rough in north, smooth or slight elsewhere.

Rain or drizzle at first in north.
Good, occasionally moderate in north.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Variable becoming southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in North Channel.
Moderate or rough in north, smooth or slight elsewhere.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel
- (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first near Mull of Kintyre, becoming variable 3
or less, then southeasterly 3 or 4 later.
Smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde, otherwise slight or moderate.
Occasional rain or drizzle at first.
Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in the North Channel.
Smooth or slight in Firth of Clyde, otherwise slight or moderate.
Mainly fair.
Moderate or good.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Westerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 or less
later in south.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwest backing southeast 3 to 5.
Moderate or rough.
Occasional drizzle at first.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

The Minch - (SWW)
24 hour forecast:
Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally 4 in south.
Slight or moderate, but rough near northern and southern entrances.
Occasional rain or drizzle.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:
Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, becoming variable 2 to 4
later.
Slight becoming smooth, but moderate or rough near northern and southern entrances.
Occasional rain or drizzle.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle at time of issue: Westerly gale force 8.

West 6 to gale 8

Rough or very rough, but moderate in sheltered eastern waters later

Occasional rain or drizzle

Moderate or good

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1800 UTC on Thursday 05 Nov until 0600 UTC on Friday 06 Nov:

West 6 to gale 8 backing southwest 5 or 6

Rough or very rough, but moderate in sheltered eastern waters

Occasional drizzle

Channel Islands - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Northeast to east 3 to 4, increasing 4 to 6 by evening.

Slight with a low swell, increasing slight to moderate by evening, locally rather rough in the west later.

Fair or fine.

East to southeast 4 to 5, occasionally 6 until Friday afternoon.

Slight to moderate, with a low swell, occasionally rather rough in the far west of the area until Friday evening.
