

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Northeastern Scotland will be generally cloudy with outbreaks of rain on
Wednesday, with snow on hills. Northern England and north Wales will be rather
cloudy with some showers at first, but elsewhere will start largely dry, cold
and sunny. However scattered showers, locally heavy, will develop widely through
the day. Rather cold with light winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:
Generally unsettled with plenty of cloud and showers or spells of rain. The best
of any dry, sunny spells are most likely in the east. Rather windy at times,
especially in the west. Temperatures near or just below normal with overnight
frosts possible.
