Inshore Waters Forecast to 12 miles offshore
for the period 0000 UTC Monday 02 November to 0000 UTC Tuesday 03 November 2015

General Situation

High pressure centred over the Continent will bring settled conditions to the British Isles during the next 24 hours, although areas of fog over the land may drift offshore to affect some coastal waters at times.

Cape Wrath to Rattray Head including Orkney - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, but 5 to 7 at first near Sutherland and Orkney, then occasionally variable 3 in south.

Moderate or rough to west and north of Orkney, otherwise slight or moderate.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Variable mainly south 3 or 4, but southwest 5 at first near Cape Wrath.

Mainly slight, but moderate occasionally rough to west and north of Orkney.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good.

Rattray Head to Berwick upon Tweed - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 in north, becoming variable 3 at times in south.

Slight, occasionally moderate in north.

Fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor in south.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then backing easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in north.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, becoming moderate or poor later.

Berwick upon Tweed to Whitby

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southwesterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first in north, then becoming variable 2 at times.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southwest, backing southeast later, 3 or 4, decreasing 2 for a time.

Smooth or slight.

Fog patches, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Whitby to Gibraltar Point

24 hour forecast:

Southerly 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 in north.

Slight.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly, backing southeasterly later, 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 in

north.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches, showers later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Gibraltar Point to North Foreland

24 hour forecast:
Variable becoming southerly or southeasterly, 3 or less, occasionally 4 later.
Smooth or slight.
Fog patches.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southeasterly 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Fog patches, showers later.
Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

North Foreland to Selsey Bill

24 hour forecast:
Variable 2 or 3 becoming easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later in west.
Slight, occasionally moderate later in west.
Fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 4 or 5, decreasing 3 at times.
Slight, occasionally moderate.
Showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Selsey Bill to Lyme Regis

24 hour forecast:
East or northeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 later.
Slight, occasionally moderate later.
Fog patches.
Moderate, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5 veering southeast 3 or 4.
Slight, occasionally moderate at first.
Showers later.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor at first.

Lyme Regis to Lands End including the Isles of Scilly - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
Easterly 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, then increasing 6 at times in west.
Slight or moderate in east, moderate in west.
Fog patches at first in east.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first in east.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East 4 or 5, veering southeast 3 or 4 later.
Slight or moderate, occasionally rough at first near the Isles of Scilly.
Rain for a time.
Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Lands End to St Davids Head including the Bristol Channel - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:
East or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 3 at first, increasing 6 at times later.
Slight or moderate.
Fog patches.
Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first, decreasing 3 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Rain for a time, mainly later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

St Davids Head to Great Orme Head, including St Georges Channel

24 hour forecast:

Southerly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 near pembrokeshire, becoming variable 2 at times in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate in far south.

Fog patches.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Easterly or southeasterly 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first near pembrokeshire, becoming variable 2 at times in north.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in far south.

Rain later.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Great Orme Head to the Mull of Galloway

24 hour forecast:

Southeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, then increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later in northwest.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East or southeast 3 or 4, increasing 5 at times.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first in northwest.

Fog patches at first, showers later.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor at first.

Isle of Man

24 hour forecast:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally variable 2 at first, then increasing 5 at times later.

Slight, occasionally moderate later.

Fog patches.

Moderate or poor, occasionally very poor.

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mull of Galloway to Mull of Kintyre including the Firth of Clyde and North Channel

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, becoming variable 3 at times.

Slight or moderate.

Fog patches at first.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight, occasionally moderate at first.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Mull of Kintyre to Ardnamurchan Point - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first.

Slight or moderate, but occasionally rough near Tiree.

Fog patches at first, drizzle at times later.

Moderate or good, occasionally very poor at first.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

South or southeast 3 or 4, occasionally 5 at first, then becoming variable 3 or less later.

Slight or moderate in south, moderate or rough in north.

Mainly fair.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

The Minch - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Slight or moderate.

Drizzle at times, mainly in north.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Ardnamurchan Point to Cape Wrath - (SWW)

24 hour forecast:

South or southwest 5 or 6, occasionally 7 at first, decreasing 4 at times later.

Moderate or rough.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

Southerly or southwesterly 4 or 5, occasionally 6 at first in north, then decreasing 2 or 3 later.

Moderate or rough, becoming slight or moderate later.

Drizzle at times.

Moderate or good, occasionally poor.

For Coastal areas up to 60 nautical miles from Lerwick, Shetland

Shetland Isles

General Situation

Pressure remains high over the North Sea while a low complex is slow moving near Iceland.

Gale Warnings in operation for Sea Area Fair Isle: southwesterly gale force 8 continuing, issued at 01/0334 UTC

Southwesterly 5 to 7, occasionally gale 8 at first in northwest.
Moderate or rough, occasionally very rough in northwest.
Occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Outlook for 12 Hours from 1200 UTC on Monday 02 Nov until 0000 UTC on Tuesday 03 Nov:

Southwest 5 to 7 backing south 4 or 5.
Moderate or rough, occasionally slight east of Shetland.
Occasional rain.
Good, occasionally moderate.

Channel Islands

24 hour forecast:

Southeast to east 2 to 3, occasionally 4, increasing 4 during the afternoon, locally 5 in the evening.
Slight.
Fine, becoming cloudy late evening.
Good, locally moderate around dawn.

Outlook for the following 24 hours:

East to southeast 4 to 5, occasionally 6, veering southerly during the afternoon and decreasing 3 to 4.
Slight increasing moderate in the north and west by dawn for a time, with a low swell.
Isolated showers in the morning and again in the evening.
Good, locally moderate in showers.

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
