

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Dry with some sunny spells across England, Wales and eastern Scotland, with the best of the sunshine near the coast. More cloud across Northern Ireland and western Scotland, with further showers for northwest Scotland. Showers will give way to more persistent rain across much of Scotland overnight, extending into Northern Ireland also. Dry with clear spells elsewhere.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Showers across many northern and western parts on Friday, heaviest and most frequent across northwest Scotland, where remaining windy. Mainly dry across the east and south on Friday and again on Saturday, but more wind and rain will move into the west.
