

Forecast For The United Kingdom  
Issued by Met Office Exeter  
at 0700 on Thursday 03 Dec 2009

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Patchy fog at first will gradually clear. Northern and eastern parts will have a cloudy day with occasional outbreaks of rain. Wales and the Southwest should be brighter with some sunny intervals but also blustery showers. Snow is likely to fall on high ground. The rain and showers will die out overnight with patchy fog forming.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

The north and east should stay dry and bright on Friday, but rain will gradually spread into the south and west. Rain at first on Saturday should clear for a while to allow some brightness, but more rain is expected later.
