Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be mostly dry and sunny today, although with low cloud perhaps near northeast coasts, and isolated afternoon showers in western Scotland. It will become cloudier in southwest England with a risk of showers, some heavy, developing in the afternoon.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:

It will be generally cloudy in the west, with rain at times, perhaps locally heavy for a period on Friday in the southwest, the rain gradually clearing northwest during Saturday. Elsewhere, some low cloud is likely about northeast coasts, otherwise the days will be mostly sunny and warm to locally very warm.
