

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Wednesday 16 Sep 2015

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of heavy rain will gradually move north across southern and then central Britain, with thundery showers following into the southeast. It will be windy in places with coastal gales likely. Northern areas remaining mostly dry with some sunny spells. Rain then easing and clearing all but the southeast overnight. Elsewhere, mainly dry with clear spells and easing winds.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Wind and rain over eastern and south-eastern parts quickly clearing to sunny spells and scattered showers for most on Thursday. Outbreaks of rain across northwest Scotland move south-eastwards and weaken. Sunny spells and scattered showers on Friday, heaviest in the south.
