Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Outbreaks of heavy rain will spread across Northern Ireland, Scotland and Northwest England. Very windy with storm force gusts in northwest Scotland. Brighter and very warm in southeast England. Rain will spread to the Southwest and Midlands later. Overnight, rain will clear southeastern areas. A few showers are likely in the north as winds ease, but most places becoming dry.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:
England and Wales will be dry, sunny and warm with scattered cloud. Bright at times in Northern Ireland and Scotland. A few showers are expected in western Scotland. Dry with long sunny periods and light winds on Thursday. Feeling pleasant.
