

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Friday 07 Jan 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Rain, sleet and snow will spread northwards to reach southern Scotland and southeast Northern Ireland this evening, but it will turn much milder with outbreaks of rain further south. Snow showers will also continue across northwestern Scotland. Overnight, significant accumulations of snow are possible across southern, eastern and northwestern Scotland, with a few centimetres also possible for southeast Northern Ireland.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Most places should become drier with bright spells over the weekend, but outbreaks of snow will continue over northern parts of the UK, these becoming confined to Scotland on Sunday. It will stay cold and quite windy, with overnight frost.
