Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It will be a cold and sunny day for most places. Snow showers in the southeast will ease through the afternoon. A few wintry showers are possible in west Wales and Cornwall too. Skies will be cloudier across Scotland and Northern Ireland with rain, sleet and snow edging southeastwards.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday will be largely cloudy with outbreaks of rain, but skies will be brighter in the far southeast. Wintry showers will push in across Northern Ireland and Scotland. Rain will clear the southeast on Friday, followed by sunshine and snow showers in the north and west.
