

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Saturday 19 Feb 2011

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Persistent rain will continue eastwards, giving occasional heavier bursts and a risk of some snowfall over hillier areas of northern Britain. Drier weather following into the west, with some sunshine and perhaps the odd shower, with brisk winds easing. Rain should clear eastern Britain early in the evening, leaving the UK mostly dry but rather cloudy.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Mostly dry and mild, if rather cloudy on Sunday. By the evening, a band of rain will move into western parts, followed by a second pulse of heavier and more persistent rain during Monday, perhaps giving hill snow in the parts of the north.
