Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
A predominantly dry and bright start but showers will start to break out in the west during the morning and become more widespread across the UK through the afternoon with some locally heavy ones. A spell of persistent rain will affect the south-east for a time. Many places becoming dry overnight but showers continuing in the south-west. Cooler and fresher.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Rather cool and bright on Thursday with a mix of sunshine and scattered heavy showers, especially inland. Feeling generally warmer on Friday with a few scattered showers but rain spreading into the south-west during the morning and pushing north-east later.
