



Storm Brian

Storm Brian was named by Met Éireann and impacted the British Isles on 21 October 2017.

Shortly after ex-Hurricane Ophelia, an area of low pressure began to rapidly intensify across the Atlantic and yellow and orange wind warnings were issued leading to Met Éireann naming the storm.

Storm Brian brought strong gusts across the UK coinciding with high tides. Impacts were most significant in Ireland and Wales with flash flooding in a number of Irish cities, while in Wales a number of seafront roads were closed and many ferries and trains cancelled.
