Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
More rain is expected over Northern Ireland , southern Scotland and northwest England at times today, but elsewhere it will be largely dry with some sunshine in places. There is just the risk of the odd isolated shower here and there. Winds strengthening later as a band of rain spreads eastwards overnight, a risk of gales around western coasts and hills.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

A band of heavy rain clearing eastwards during the morning and it will be windy too. Brighter weather to follow for the rest of Thursday and Friday, most places dry, though patchy rain may affect the east coast at times.
