

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:  
Stronger winds and locally heavy rain spreading into northwestern parts through the day. Gales in northwest Scotland. Elsewhere, mostly dry and very warm with sunny periods. Overnight, rain easing and moving southeastwards into northern England and Wales, followed by clear spells and the odd shower. Dry elsewhere with some clear periods.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Thursday, rather cloudy with patchy rain across Wales and northern and western England. Southeastern parts dry, fine and very warm. Fresher across Scotland and Northern Ireland, with showers and some sunshine. Friday, wet and windy conditions in northwest moving southeastwards, but southeastern parts should remain mostly fine and warm.
