Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
A dry start in the east, with some early sunshine. Cloud and blustery showers in the west will spread to most parts, some heavy downpours likely, perhaps with thunder in places. Turning dry in many parts tonight, but still wet at times in the west. Windy, with gales in the northwest, and gusty in heavier showers. Temperatures near normal.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Heavy rain in the far southwest early Sunday, will spread quickly to all areas, bringing the risk of flooding. Very windy with gales or severe gales. Rain clearing the far south on Monday, otherwise sunshine and scattered showers. Temperatures around normal.
