General Situation

A weak area of low pressure over Ireland will fill and eventually lose its identity early on Friday. An area of high pressure will then build over Scotland as low pressure develops over France.

Channel Islands

Northeasterly 3 to 5, perhaps 6 for a time after dawn mid channel, becoming variable 1 to 2 for a time later in the east, then the south of the area.
Smooth to slight with a low swell at first, increasing moderate after midnight in the northwest of the area.
Rain or showers for a time, mainly at first, perhaps locally heavy, occasional drizzle later.
