Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Heavy rain fringing southeast England and East Anglia. Slow moving, thundery showers developing over many central and northern parts. Rain over Northern Ireland easing. Brighter spells between, and drier generally for parts of Wales, southwest England and northeast In Scotland, heavy, showery rain will clear eastern areas overnight, where it will become breezy. Otherwise largely with clear spells.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Rain affecting Shetland at times Saturday. The rest of the UK bright and breezy, with a good deal of sunshine and a few showers. Showers most likely in the west. Sunday could see a spell of wet and windy weather.
