

Forecast For The United Kingdom
Issued by Met Office Exeter
at 0700 on Tuesday 23 Sep 2014

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Patchy rain moving steadily southwards across northern England and northern Wales, becoming locally heavy this afternoon. Mostly dry and bright elsewhere after a chilly start, but further rain spreading into northwest Scotland and Northern Ireland later. Overnight, rain across northwestern parts continuing southeastwards, reaching the southeast later. Drier and clearer conditions following as the rain clears.

Outlook for Wednesday and Thursday:

Patchy rain across southern parts clearing during Wednesday morning. Otherwise plenty of dry and bright weather, but a few showers transferring eastwards. Thursday, southern and eastern parts staying dry and fine. Windier and cloudier further north and west, with some rain at times.
