

Forecast For The United Kingdom

Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Brisk southwesterly winds will bring areas of persistent rain and also scattered showers. The heaviest, and most thundery, showers are expected over northern parts. Heavy showers are possible elsewhere but much less intense than those of yesterday. It will feel much fresher today but generally drier and brighter, with lengthy spells of sunshine in eastern parts. Further patchy rain overnight.

Outlook for Saturday and Sunday:

Bright and breezy for most on Saturday, but with scattered showers, some heavy and perhaps thundery. Cloudy though in Northern Ireland and the Scottish Islands, with more prolonged rain. Sunday mostly dry but with some light showers in the east.
