Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
Sleet and snow showers will ease across northern Britain leaving many places with a dry and fine day. However, a few wintry showers will continue across some western areas and it will be cold and windy for many. A cold night will follow, with clear spells and lighter winds giving a fairly widespread frost.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

A band of squally rain will move across the UK on Tuesday, clearing southern England overnight. Sleet and snow showers will follow across the north, with further frequent wintry showers on Wednesday. It will be cold and very windy, with severe gales across northwestern Britain.
