Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Scotland and northern England will see a dry day, with some sunshine, although freezing fog will linger in places. Central, southern and eastern England will have cold, grey day, with occasional drizzle. Also cloudy and damp at times across southwest England, Wales and Northern Ireland, but here it will be a little milder.

Outlook for Tuesday and Wednesday:

Rain will affect Northern Ireland and perhaps western Scotland on Tuesday and Wednesday, with the risk of sleet or snow on its eastern edge. Elsewhere, barring a few wintry showers across eastern England, generally dry, but with hard overnight frosts and a risk of stubborn freezing fog.
