Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow :
Snow showers will continue to affect northern Scotland, Northern Ireland, north Wales, parts of northwest England and the Midlands and some North Sea coasts. There should be a lot of dry, fine weather away from these areas with good sunny spells and just isolated light snow showers. Feeling chilly.

Snow showers overnight should mainly affect northern and eastern Scotland and Northern Ireland. Generally dry and clear elsewhere but some sleet or snow possible close to English Channel coasts. Very cold with a widespread frost.

Outlook for Friday and Saturday:
Remaining cold and unsettled with further showers of sleet and snow, especially in northern areas.
