Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom until dawn tomorrow:
It's a grey and wet start across the southern half of the UK, but northern, central and southeastern parts of England are expected to turn brighter later. In southwest England and Wales it is likely to stay wet and windy. Northern Ireland and Scotland will have sunshine and showers.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Sunday will be sunny, windy and cold for most, with blustery showers in many coastal regions, and across northern Scotland. Some will be heavy, and perhaps wintry in the far northeast, and over higher ground elsewhere. Monday will start bright and frosty, with cloud and rain in the northwest later.
