Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Outbreaks of rain across Wales and southern England, which will be heavy at times, before slowly clearing south-eastwards during the day. Meanwhile, much of Scotland, Northern Ireland and parts of northern England will be mostly dry and bright, with sunny spells. However, there will be some blustery showers in the far northwest. It will be less mild than recent days.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Drier and brighter for many on Sunday, particularly in the south and east. Cloudier elsewhere, with patchy drizzle at times, mainly western hills. Rain will spread eastwards on Monday, with brighter skies in the west later. Generally frost-free by night.
