Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain across much of England and Wales will clear the southeast of England by mid-afternoon. Brighter conditions in the northwest will spread across the UK with showers affecting western areas. These may turn wintry on hills, but also to lower levels in the north. Strong winds are expected for most throughout the day.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Wintry showers in the northwest will ease early on Thursday, with a frosty start for many. Cloud will increase through the day, with a risk of some light rain in the west. Winds will ease by Friday and it will turn milder, although still rather cloudy.
