Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:
Rain should clear the southeast first thing, then showers, wintry in the north, will spread from the west affecting most parts of England, Wales and northern Scotland throughout the day. Central Scotland should stay mainly dry, but patchy freezing fog is likely in places. It will be cold but not as cold as previous days.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:
Rain will clear to drier spells across southeastern and eastern areas early on Sunday, but wintry showers will continue in northern parts of the UK, with snow in the far north. There will be freezing fog and frost in places, with temperatures turning colder again.
