Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :
An unsettled day with rather a lot of cloud generally, along with showers or longer spells of rain. Eastern parts of Scotland and northern England, in particular, could see some heavy, persistent rain, while showers near to southern coasts may be heavy and thundery. The best of the drier, brighter spells are likely over northwestern Scotland, and across eastern parts of southern England. A breezy day for many, the winds locally strong over some southern and eastern districts, making it feel rather chilly.

Outlook for Sunday and Monday:

Unsettled conditions will continue with showers or longer spells of rain, interspersed with drier and brighter spells.
