Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow:  
Sunday will be generally cloudy and mild, with drizzle over western hills, and with some heavier rain in the far northwest later. There'll be some brighter spells at times, more especially so in the east and in areas sheltered by hills. It will be very mild for all, with afternoon temperatures into double figures.

Outlook for Monday and Tuesday:

Rain across northern England at first on Monday will sink southwards during the day, followed by colder and brighter weather, with scattered showers likely across Scotland. A frosty start for some on Tuesday, but with rain across Scotland, and rain developing elsewhere later in the day.
