Here is the forecast for the United Kingdom for daytime tomorrow :  
Rain, locally heavy, and strong winds will push north across Scotland, but should quickly clear from eastern England. Otherwise, rather cloudy with some blustery showers, driest inland in England. Gales in Cornwall later. Generally warm but only feeling so in the sunshine.

Outlook for Thursday and Friday:

Windy with gales, possible severe gales across southern England on Thursday. Less windy to the north. Sunny spells and blustery showers, heavy in places. Rather warm.

Showers, some heavy, will cross the UK from the west during Friday morning with drier conditions and sunny spells following. Breezy, windy across Scotland with gales possible initially. Temperatures around normal.
